Stage One: Online Academy Sessions

Weekends of group workshops and Individually scheduled online sessions take place through the year, exploring topics such as Italian diction and recitatives, score study & role preparation, audition preparation & professional presentation, stylistic traditions in opera, and "the business of singing," including marketing, social media, etc.
